TreeHouse Wildlife Center will be open to the public starting June 5th, from 10am-4pm, Fridays-Sundays. The Education Center will only be open for visitors to use the restroom facilities. We are requesting that masks are worn in the Education Center, with no more than 10 people inside at a time. We also ask that social distancing be respected inside and outside. All other areas of the building will be closed to the public but everyone is welcome to visit our resident animals on our grounds. Please, please help us by following our guidelines and be kind to our staff and volunteers as we navigate through the requirements placed by state and federal guidelines. We need to ensure we do not jeopardize any state or federal permits that could result in permanently closing our facility.

We hope you will respect the fact we are still receiving wild babies and are without many of our volunteers. The health and care of our animals is our first priority. We have a few species we need to work to protect from possible cross-contamination. We hope to be back to normal visiting hours soon. We will be reevaluating our policies weekly. Thank you!
